Dear Clerk of the Court:

You have violated my Constitutional rights by refusing to file my lawsuits. I have presented two verified complaints with the cover sheet and all necessary forms and the fee. These each included emergency motions for TROs.

If you do not file these immediately, I will sue personally every employee in the Clerk's office who has participated in this pursuant to *Bivens v. Six Unknown Federal Narcotics Agents*. I will seek damages from each person individually.

Please call me today to advise if these actions have been filed. If I do not hear from you today, I will file a lawsuit against all of you in Washington, DC on Friday.

I am also enclosing a rough draft of "The Rotten Peaches Brief." This is a document that I am preparing for the media, the President, the Presidential candidates, every member of Congress, every U.S. Attorney in Atlanta, the brass with the FBI and the Attorney General's Office, and assorted others. Once you review this, I believe you as a government employee in your position have a legal obligation to report the evil-doers to the Bar Association, the judicial conduct people, Congress, and the President. Failure to do so will make you guilty of judicial misconduct and crimes.
