

**ORDER**

Certain defendants filed a Request for Specific Approval to File Rule 11 Motion [137]. This Court granted that request [140]. Those defendants then filed a Motion for Sanctions Against Plaintiff Under Rule 11 and This Court's Inherent Authority By Defendants Hawkins Parnell Thackston & Young LLP, Carl H. Anderson, Jr., Maid of the Mist Corporation, Christopher M. Glynn, Robert J. Schul, Maid of the Mist Steamboat Company, Ltd., Timothy P. Ruddy, Sandra Carlson, Phillips Lytle, LLP, Arthur Russ, and Marc W. Brown (the "Rule 11 Motion") [148]. The paragraph in the Order dated October 19, 2010 [161] that denied without prejudice the Rule 11 Motion is **VACATED**. The Clerk is **DIRECTED** to mark the Rule 11 Motion as an open motion on the docket.

This Court indicated that a briefing schedule for the Rule 11 Motion would be set after the stay in this case was lifted [140 at 6]. The stay has been lifted. Windsor shall have until November 10, 2010, to file a response to the Rule 11 Motion. The defendants who filed the Rule 11 Motion shall have until November 24, 2010, to reply, although no reply shall be required. *See* LR 7.1C, NDGa.
