Dear Mrs. Keel and Mr. Howard:

I have left two voice mails for Mrs. Keel that have not been answered. Please call me as soon as possible.

I wish to file a criminal complaint for Tampering with the Grand Jury, violation of oath of office, Obstruction of Justice, Conspiracy, and RICO.

Mr. Settles did not allow me to speak to the Grand Jury, and he did not allow me to present the evidence that I brought -- 164 exhibits that I prepared and had at the door to your office in two full copy paper cases.

I need the names and contact information for the Grand Jurors so I can determine who tampered with them. Mr. Broadbent and Mr. Settles both claim it wasn't them. We shall see who did what. I ask you to go speak with the white woman, dark hair, perhaps 45 years old, from New York who was seated in the front row on the far right when I was there. She said she had been told that all I do is file frivolous lawsuits. Whoever told her that tampered with the Grand Jury. You might also speak with the white man, beard, wears suspenders; he seemed honest.

If my assumption from adding 2 and 2 is correct, the Grand Jurors were taken to the second floor just before they met with me. That is undoubtedly where the tampering took place.

I need a copy of the tape recording from Friday and from today.

I demand an audience with the Grand Jury on Friday, and I demand that Mr. Settles and Mr. Broadbent be kept out of the room.

I demand an audience with Mr. Howard and you to discuss my complaints against the District Attorney's Office.

Please advise if I can have my binders back. The dividers cost almost \$700, and I can't afford to buy more.

FYI: Waverly Settles has threatened to sue me for libel/defamation. He says that when I wrote this, it constitutes libel or defamation:

"I was very disappointed that the Grand Jury was told that I was a lunatic and did nothing but file frivolous lawsuits BEFORE I appeared. It is crystal clear to me that someone committed the crime of jury tampering with your Grand Jury. I suspect it was Waverly Settles and Steve Broadbent."

Please ask Mr. Settles to send me the statute and case law that says saying you suspect something is libel, slander, or defamation. This will be news to me
