Dear Mr. Howard:

Yesterday, Ms. Cynthia Nwokocha committed several crimes in the elevator lobby of the third floor, gave me a “Criminal Trespass Warning” and had me removed from the building.

The second paragraph of the “Criminal Trespass Warning” says to call Ms. Nwokocha “if you have any questions, or if you request to enter the Fulton County District Attorney’s Office property for a specific purpose....”

I called twice today, and Ms. Nwokocha hung up on me both times. I was merely calling as SHE directed in writing. On the second call, she said she will charge me with harassment if I called again.

So, please have someone other than Ms. Nwokocha call me at 770-578-1094 to answer questions and to accept my request to enter the Fulton County District Attorney’s Office property for a specific purpose.

I also demand a hearing on this “Criminal Trespass Warning.” Ms. Nwokocha has found me guilty of a crime, and the law says I am innocent until proven guilty.

I demand a copy of any rules, regulations, or statutes that give Ms. Nwokocha any legal authority to issue such a Warning and to arrange for my arrest for returning to the elevator lobby.

I demand to see copies of all such “Criminal Trespass Warnings” ever issued to anyone else.

I demand to see proof that the elevator lobby on the third floor is the “Fulton County District Attorney’s Property.” According to Fulton County, the Office of the Fulton County District Attorney owns no property. The courthouse is owned by the citizens of Fulton County.

I demand to see proof of what exactly Ms. Nwokocha claims I violated in O.C.G.A. 16-7-21.

Please respond immediately.
