AFFIDAVIT OF SABRINA FELTON DATED AUGUST 31, 2011

I, Sabrina Felton, Windsor, the undersigned, hereby declare under penalty of perjury:

1. My name is Sabrina Felton.

2. I am over the age of 21 and am competent to testify.

3. I met William M. Windsor through his website www.LawlessAmerica.com. We have spoken on the phone several times, have exchanged emails, and have met three times in the elevator lobby outside the office of the Fulton County District Attorney's Office at 136 Pryor Street, Third Floor, Atlanta, Georgia 30303.

4. On August 30, 2011, I arrived at the Fulton County Courthouse and the public lobby outside the Fulton County District Attorney's Office at approximately 11:55 am.

5. I saw Mr. Windsor, and we remained together during my visit until I was ordered to leave.

6. I brought a CONFIDENTIAL envelope of evidence and information to have delivered to the Grand Jury. I walked over to the receptionist's window, and I politely asked Naomi Fudge to give my evidence and information to the Grand Jury. Ms. Fudge refused. Mr. Windsor witnessed this.

7. A few minutes later, Ms. Cynthia Nwokocha, Chief Investigator for the Fulton County District Attorney, appeared. Mr. Windsor advised me that Ms. Nwokocha was a woman who could give her evidence to the Grand Jury as she had done so for him once. Ms. Nwokocha was combative with me. I demanded my rights. Ms. Nwokocha told me that a citizen has no rights to present evidence to a grand jury. Mr. Windsor was standing back just a bit, and when

Ms. Nwokocha gave this information that Mr. Windsor and I believe is false, he very politely said what she had said was not true. There is nothing in the Georgia statutes that prohibits a citizen from presenting information to a grand jury. Ms. Nwokocha told Windsor to get out of the conversation even though he and I were there together at that point. Mr. Windsor did, and he did not speak to her again while I was speaking with her. There were many people in the lobby.

8. Ms. Nwokocha ordered me from the building, and she left. Ms. Nwokocha then ordered Mr. Windsor to leave as well. He told her that he was not going anywhere. She then called the Sheriff's Department and said she was issuing a Criminal Trespass Warning to Mr. Windsor. Mr. Windsor did absolutely nothing improper. He was courteous and professional at all times. He never raised his voice as Ms. Nwokocha did. He said he was simply there to present evidence to the Grand Jury.


9. I believe that Ms. Nwokocha and others are guilty of obstruction of justice and violation of O.C.G.A. 16-10-93 and O.C.G.A. 16-10-94.

10. I have evidence of criminal acts by employees of the Fulton County District Attorney's Office.
