Mr. Chamberlain and Ms. Schnizler:

I am planning to subpoena 10 of the Defendants for the Hearing scheduled for July 7. I plan to subpoena five non-Defendants, and I will have three other witnesses to testify.

Since I need to pay the witness and mileage fee to each person subpoenaed, it would be helpful if the testimony could be scheduled so those subpoenaed do not have to come several days. My recommendation is that I testify on Friday, October 7 and call the non-party witnesses first thing the next day. Will the hearing be continued to Monday, October 10? Following the non-party witnesses, I will call the Defendants.

If you could let me know if I should date my subpoenas for testimony on the 10th, I would certainly appreciate it.

Attached is a motion that is being filed first thing Monday seeking to have recording of the Hearing.

I do plan to present both audio and video recordings. Is the courtroom equipped with equipment to use for this purpose?

I will advise counsel for the Defendants as soon as I know who they are, but I have a vision handicap. I have difficulty reading anything in small type unless I can read it at a distance of 30-inches from my eyes. I see double when looking at things less than 30-inches from my eyes. Counsel for the Defendants should plan appropriately if they want to examine me about any documents or written material.

I am attempting to identify the counsel for the Defendants so counsel can be copied on all communications. I have copies of everything, and I will provide all to them as soon as I know who they are.
