## **DECLARATION OF MARC W. BROWN**

MARC W. BROWN states and declares that the following statements are true and correct and based upon his own personal knowledge:

1.

My name is Marc W. Brown.

2.

I have been a lawyer for ten (10) years. I have continuously engaged in fulltime private practice in Buffalo, New York. I am the New York counsel representing Plaintiffs in the above-styled case. I have been admitted *pro hac vice* in the above-styled matter.

3.

This Affidavit is given in support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Post-Judgment Attorney's Fees and Expenses Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1927, This Court's Inherent Authority, and O.C.G.A. §13-6-11, and Indwelling Memorandum of Law, and for all other motions for attorney's fees and expenses filed by Plaintiffs.

4.

I am employed as an associate attorney by the law firm of Phillips Lytle, LLP ("PL"). PL serves as counsel for Plaintiffs in New York and the above-styled action. A copy of the law firm's entry in Martindale-Hubbell is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" to outline the experience level of the attorneys who have worked on this file. Before working for PL, I worked as judicial clerk for New York State Supreme Court Appellate Division, Fourth Department, between 1999 and 2001.

5.

I am a graduate of the State University of New York at Buffalo. I am admitted to practice in New York, the United States District Court, Western District of New York, the United States Court of Appeals, Second Circuit, and the

United States Bankruptcy Court, Western District of New York. I am a member of the New York State Bar Association, American Bar Association, and the Bar Association of Erie County. I am a member of the State University of New York at Buffalo School of Law Alumni Association, Board of Directors; and the State University of New York at Binghamton, Harpur College, National Law Advisory Council, Board of Directors.

6.

My law practice is concentrated in the area of litigation pertaining to contractual disputes, real property, personal injury, products liability, toxic torts and collection enforcement. My current billing rate is \$235.00. I have billed clients at those rates, have invoiced them, and have received payment from them at those rates.

7.

PL assigned this file to me because I have previous experience handling business tort and injunctive relief litigation. My billing rates have increased during my representation of the Plaintiffs. I have attached a table using information available in the Buffalo area to help me establish that the PL timekeepers' rates are reasonable. A copy of the table is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B".

It is my experience and opinion that the quantity of time worked by Plaintiffs' counsel for which compensation is sought is reasonable and consistent with the requirements of this case and the billing judgment exercised in comparable cases in the Buffalo market for comparable legal services. The staffing on these cases and the time charges resulting from these staffing decisions appear, in my judgment, to be reasonable, necessary, and consistent with the prevailing market conditions for the delivery of comparable legal services in comparable cases. Based on my review of the table attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and my knowledge of rates in the Buffalo area, PL timekeepers' rates are reasonable.

9.

I am the attorney at PL who is most familiar with this case having spent numerous hours working on this file.

10.

It is the policy and practice of attorneys, paralegals, and librarians at PL to enter time into the law firm's time-keeping computer program contemporaneously with the performance of the service rendered or as soon thereafter as practicable. Each timekeeper enters time in the computer in six (6) minute increments or tenths

(1/10th) of an hour. Each timekeeper must input the client number, the matter number, the time expended, a description of the service performed, and, in some cases, client-specific task codes. In this case, the client number is 71752 and the matter number is 00006. Once each timekeeper has released his time, the accounting department can generate a pre-bill which sets forth the name of the timekeeper, the date the service was rendered, the amount of time expended, a description of the service rendered, and, in some cases, client-specific task codes. PL's time and billing records are kept in the ordinary course of business. PL stores the bills which PL generates in the file. I am custodian of this file.

11.

I have reviewed the file in which PL keeps the bills that it generates. I derived the information in billing abstract from the billing files. Declarant will supplement his Declaration with Excel® billing abstracts under Rule 54(d)(2)(B) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and LR 54.2A(2). The following table sets forth the abbreviations which identify certain timekeepers.

I calculated the amount of attorney's fees due by multiplying the total number of hours that an individual worked on the file by that individual's billing rate. Then, I added the products of each of the calculations together. The sum of that calculation equaled the amount of attorney's fees. Based on these calculations, the amount of attorney's fees incurred by Plaintiffs through December 31, 2009 for the handling of the litigation is \$16,446.89. This represents 70.6 hours of time. The expenses (including items that may be taxed as costs in a bill of costs) total \$45.30. Declarant will supplement his Declaration with Excel® billing abstracts under Rule 54(d)(2)(B) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and LR 54.2A(2).

I am more than 21 years of age and is competent to testify to the matters set forth herein. This declaration is made upon my personal knowledge, in compliance with the Order, dated and any other purposes permitted by law.




