MOTION TO MODIFY
SCHEDULING ORDER

Comes now William Windsor, DEFENDANT,
WHO FILES THIS "MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULING
ORDER;" and shows the court as follows:

INTRODUCTION

1. TWO WEEKS IS NOT ENOUGH TIME FOR WILLIAM
M. WINDSOR TO PREPARE FOR THE TRIAL-TRAIL
CONFERENCE. WILLIAM M. WINDSOR HAS
RECEIVED ONLY 14 PAGES OF EVIDENCE
FROM THE PROSECUTION DESPITE REQUESTS
THAT HAVE BEEN WAY OUTSTANDING.

WILLIAM M. WINDSOR'S REQUESTS TO
DEPOSE THE STATE'S WITNESSES HAVE
BEEN IGNORED. WILLIAM M. WINDSOR'S
CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS HAVE BEEN

DENIED TO HIM AND TO HIS PROSECUTOR HIS
TRAIL COUNSEL. IT WILL BE ANOTHER
SIGNIFICANT VIOLATION OF WILLIAM M.
WINDSOR'S RIGHTS IF HE HAS TO PRODUCE
THEIR WITNESSES AND WITNESS LISTS
WITHOUT OBTAINING DISCOVERY.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

1. William M. Windsor has been incarcerated for 131 days. He has been denied access to his evidence, legal files, computer, legal research, ^{and now} incorporation. William M. Windsor's motion for constitutional rights was denied by this court.
2. William M. Windsor sent a discovery request to the prosecution on or about April 3, 2015. Nothing was ever provided.
3. William M. Windsor signed the omnibus memorandum on April 21, 2015. It says the prosecution turned over all evidence at that time. Nothing was provided.

So on May 5, 2015, William M. Winslow
RECEIVED 14 PAGES FROM A PUBLIC
DEFENDER CHRISTOPHER DARY THAT
HE SAYS IS ALL THE EVIDENCE TELLING
THE PROSECUTION. THIS IS HARD TO
BELIEVE AS THERE WAS NOTHING OTHER
THAN WHAT APPEARS TO BE A POST-
ARREST POLICE REPORT.

b. William M. Winslow HAS BEEN
ASKING THE PROSECUTION FOR
WEEKS ABOUT SURVEY MEASURES
FOR DEPOSITIONS, REQUESTING
AVAILABLE DATES. NO OFFERS
HAVE EVER BEEN PROVIDED.
AND AS A PRO SE PARTY, WILLIAM
M. WINSLOW HAS TO OBTAIN
APPROVAL OF THE COURT.

7. On May 6, 2015 at 7:30pm, William
M. Winslow RECEIVED THE "COURT
JULY TERM PREPARATION ORDER"
SETTING MAY 22, 2015 AS THE
PEN-TRAIL CONFERENCE. William
M. Winslow IS SUPPOSED TO HAVE
EXHIBIT / WITNESS BINDERS
PREPARED BY THEN.

Argument

8. William M. Winslow NEEDS TIME TO SUBPOENA EVIDENCE AND DEPOSE WITNESSES. 16 DAYS IS INSUFFICIENT AND CONSTITUTES A SIGNIFICANT VIOLATION OF WILLIAM M. WINSLOW'S DUE PROCESS RIGHTS AND RIGGERS TO A FAIR TRIAL.

9. Subpoenas to TWITTER, AT&T, FACEBOOK, AND SONY BROADCAST'S EMAIL ACCOUNTS WILL LIKELY TAKE MONTHS. MOST OF THESE COMPANIES ARE IN GEORGIA WHERE WILLIAM M. WINSLOW WILL HAVE TO FILE A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST EACH COMPANY TO OBTAIN DISCOVERY METO & CAUTIOUSLY. Ltrs.

10. William M. Winslow HAS SUPPORTIVE WITNESSES IN GEORGIA, FLORIDA, TEXAS, COLORADO, SOUTH, AND OTHER STATES THAT WILL REQUIRE TRAVEL FOR DEPOSITIONS.

11. William M. Winsor NEEDS TESTIMONY
FROM JUDGES AND ATTORNEYS, JUDGES
JOHN W. LEXSON, JUSTICE IN
BOSTON, TWO JUDGES FROM BOSTON,
THESE JUDGES HAVE BUSY
SCHEDULES AND MANY PLEADING
DEPOSITIONS.

12. William M. Winsor HAS MADE
REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION RELEVANT
TO POLICE DEPARTMENT, COURTS CREEKS
AND OTHERS NO ONE HAS RESPONDED.

13. IF THIS IS TO BE A KANGAROO
Court, William M. Winsor may BE
Found guilty WHEN HE IS
ABSOLUTELY INNOCENT. AMERICANS
ARE NOT SUPPOSED TO HAVE
KANGAROO COURTS. William M.
Winsor's RIGHTS will BE
