ORDER OF VOLUNTARY RECUSAL


On October 3, 2016, the Court considered the second motion to recuse filed by the defendant, William M. Windsor, in the above-captioned cause.

Having considered the motion, the Court **FINDS** the allegations contained in the motion do not support recusal. The Court does not harbor any personal bias or prejudice against the defendant, William M. Windsor, nor does the Court lack impartiality. The Court remains able to base its decision on the facts as they develop at trial, and to render a fair judgment in this case.

While the Court is qualified to participate in this case, the Court finds the interest of judicial economy along with the appearance of propriety dictate the Court sua sponte recuse itself from any further proceedings in this case.

So that all parties in this case will have confidence in a fair and impartial tribunal, the Court asks that the Presiding Judge of the First Administrative Region assign a judge to preside over this case.
